 - Easter Sunday Praise at 10:30 am led by Simon.



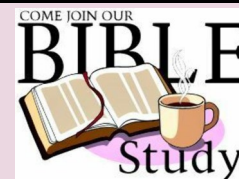

- An online Bible Study group on zoom on Thursday evenings between 7:30 pm and 8:30 pm. Please speak to Simon if you would like the Zoom link.

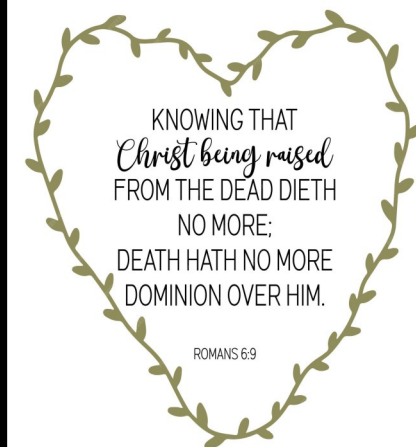
